Kingsfield Golf & Leisure: Membership Terms and Conditions

“Kingsfield Golf & Leisure” and “Kingsfield Golf Centre” are trading names for Kingsfield Leisure Limited, a company registered in Scotland (Company Number SC324176) and having our registered office at c/o Barclays, Mill Road Industrial Estate, Linlithgow Bridge, Linlithgow, West Lothian EH49 7SF (hereafter referred to as “Kingsfield”, or “we”, “our” or “us”).

Except where expressly agreed otherwise by us in writing every member (and their guest(s)) of Kingsfield shall be subject to these terms and conditions. We reserve the right to use discretion in all matters relating to membership. We reserve the right to amend the terms and conditions at any time without prior warning.

Kingsfield is affiliated to Scottish Golf and offers two categories of membership: Junior and Adult. These terms apply to both categories.

1. Membership is continuous until revoked in writing and acknowledged.
2. The membership year begins on April 1 and subscriptions are paid annually in advance. A member joins each year for a minimum period of one year unless s/he joins partway through a year in which case the member is responsible for his/her subscription up to the end of the standard yearly period. A member should write or email to inform us that s/he no longer wishes to continue his/her membership. A member is responsible for his/her fees up to March 31 each year.
3. Members joining mid-year will pay pro-rata to the nearest month.
4. All members are responsible for their guests. A member may not introduce the same guest any more than three times in any one year.
5. Members will be notified by email of any changes to subscription fees; the website will detail other changes and charges. Membership renewal emails are sent out circa March 1.
6. Membership payments not received within one month of becoming due will result in an administration fee of £30. Should the membership and administration fee not be paid, membership will be considered cancelled.
7. No refund will be made on resignation for membership payments received.
8. Kingsfield will endeavour to provide golf courses in the best condition possible. This may, from time to time, result in closure of holes or parts of holes to make improvements considered to be in the best interest of members and players.
9. The course, short game area, putting green and/or driving range may be closed during extreme weather conditions or for competitions and for booked play outside of members' times.
10. Members wishing the opportunity to play competitive golf in official club competitions require to be members of Kingsfield Golf Society (currently £30/year). We **will not** share your personal data with the Society so members wishing to join must email gregoraitken@hotmail.com (t: 07850 546880).
11. All members (and their guests) agree to abide by Kingsfield's policies and code of conduct. Members (and their guest(s)):
 - **Must not** publish any information on any social media platform which is hearsay, non-factual or opinions which may discredit Kingsfield Golf & Leisure, any member of Kingsfield, or any member of staff of Kingsfield;
 - **Must not** use foul, abusive, degrading or discriminatory language;
 - **Must not** use mobile phones on the course, unless in an emergency;
 - **Must not** cheat on the course;
 - **Must not** persistently slow play during competitions;
 - **Must not** endanger fellow players on the course by playing whilst they are in range or not alerting them (Fore) to a ball that could potentially hit them;
 - **Must not** ignore course signage;
 - **Must not** repeatedly fail to replace fairway divots or repair pitch marks on the green.
 - **Must not** leave golf bags/clubs in the reception area or Tee Caddy coffee shop.
 - **Must not** wear their golf shoes indoors.
 - **Must** leave golf bags/clubs in their car until ready to play.
 - **Must** wear smart-casual attire – no football strips, tee shirts, track suit bottoms or jeans to be worn.
 - **Must** report to reception on arrival to receive a ticket and score card before going on the course.

Any member infringing clause 11 may incur expulsion and risks not being invited to renew their membership.
